

AXE THROWING

SAFETY RULES AXE THROWING

PLEASE READ THESE RULES TO EVERY PARTICIPANT

- Axe participants must be over the age of 13 and be physically able to throw an axe at a target safely.
- Angel participants must be over the age of 10 and be physically able to throw an angle knife at a target safely.
- Participants must not be under the influence of drink or drugs.
- Always listen to your instructor and follow the instructions given to you.
- Axes must never be thrown when a person or animal is within the lane.
- Pick up your axe using the handle and look out for splinters.
- Dangerous behaviour will result in the end of your session.
- Entry to the range, past the spectator rail is by invitation only.
- Do not cross the safety line until all throwers axes have come to complete stop and your instructor confirms it is okay to do so.

SUPERVISION

- Children must be accompanied on site at all times by a minimum of 1 adult (18+) to supervise behaviour.
- Accompanying adults must remain on the range for the duration of the session.

BEFORE YOUR ADVENTURE BEGINS

- You are suitably dressed with laces tied, **NO HOODS** and clothing secured.
- Closed-toe shoes must be worn by all participants.
