

RIFLE SHOOTING

SAFETY RULES RIFLE SHOOTING

PLEASE READ THESE RULES TO EVERY PARTICIPANT

- All participants must be over the age of 14.
- Participants must not be under the influence of drink or drugs.
- Always listen to your instructor and follow the instructions given to you.
- Rifles must never be fired when a person or animal is within the range.
- Rifles must only be pointed down range.
- Dangerous behaviour will result in the end of your session.

SUPERVISION

- Children aged 14 or over must be accompanied on site by minimum of 1 adult (18+) to supervise behaviour.
- Accompanying adults must remain on the range for the duration of the session.

THE FIREARMS ACT 1968: SECTION 21

- Participants must not be subject to any restrictions by virtue of Section 21 of the Firearms act 1968 or any other law restricting the use of guns. (Which applies to persons who have been sentenced to a term of imprisonment, youth custody or suspended sentence).

BEFORE YOUR ADVENTURE BEGINS

- You are suitably dressed, with laces tied and clothing secured.
- Closed-toe shoes must be worn by all participants.

AFTER YOUR SESSION

- Ensure you wash hands to remove residual lead from pellets.
